

Articles of Organization

Of

Trauma Informed Systems of Care, LLC

Executed on this 5th day of September, 2025.

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Article I. Name

The name of the limited liability company is Trauma Informed Systems of Care, LLC (the “Company”).

Article II. Duration

The duration of the Company shall be perpetual, unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the Kansas Revised Limited Liability Company Act or the Company’s Operating Agreement.

Article III. Registered Office and Registered Agent

Article IV. Principal Office

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Article V. Purpose

The purpose for which the Company is organized is expressly limited to the following, and the Company shall not engage in unrelated business activities:

1. Consulting, Training, and Systems Design

- To advise, train, and support health care, educational, governmental, and social service organizations in the design, implementation, and evaluation of trauma-informed systems of care.
- To provide structured organizational transformation services consistent with established trauma-informed care principles, including: safety, trustworthiness, collaboration, empowerment, and choice.

2. Application and Technology Development

- To design, develop, and deploy software applications, including but not limited to those built upon FHIR-based frameworks that enable organizations to implement trauma-informed practices, track outcomes, support workforce training, and improve patient and community engagement.
- To integrate health information technology, data collection, and interoperability tools that advance trauma-informed service delivery.

3. Policy, Research, and Advocacy

- To conduct and disseminate research on trauma-informed approaches in health care, education, and community systems.
- To collaborate with government agencies, payers, and policymakers in advancing payment, policy, and program reforms that sustain trauma-informed care.
- To provide technical assistance, educational programming, and advocacy to promote trauma-informed practices at local, state, and federal levels.

4. Educational and Community Engagement Activities

- To develop, distribute, and present educational resources and training programs for providers, organizations, and the general public to increase awareness of trauma and its impact on health, education, and social outcomes.
- To promote initiatives that prevent re-traumatization, reduce stigma, and improve workforce well-being.

5. General Powers

- To carry on any and all activities related or incidental to the foregoing purposes, and to have and exercise all powers available to a limited liability company under the Kansas Revised Limited Liability Company Act, provided that the Company shall not engage in any business or activities not expressly permitted to be carried out by a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Kansas.

Article VI. Management

The Company shall be member-managed. The management of the Company shall be vested in its members.

Article VII. Membership Interests

The Company is authorized to issue 100 membership shares.

All 100 membership shares are issued to and owned by Patrick Allan Blanchard, MD, who is the sole member of the Company.


Article VIII. Limitation of Liability

No member or manager of the Company shall be personally liable for the debts, obligations, or liabilities of the Company solely by reason of being a member or manager, to the maximum extent permitted by the Kansas Revised Limited Liability Company Act.

Article IX. Indemnification

The Company shall indemnify its members, managers, officers, employees, and agents to the fullest extent permitted by law, as provided in the Operating Agreement or by resolution of the members.
